

RECOMMENDATION:

- Reject the Transitions Commute Solutions, LLC proposal as being nonresponsive to Request for Proposals 2017-2.
- Approve Resolution No. 2018-01 recommending the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged designate Suwannee River Economic Council, Inc. the Community Transportation Coordinator for Bradford County for a five-year period effective July 1, 2018.

BACKGROUND:

The Council is the Designated Official Planning Agency for the Transportation Disadvantaged Program for Bradford County. The Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged requires that the designated official planning agencies conduct the selection process and recommend a Community Transportation Coordinator at the end of each contract period.

Suwannee River Economic Council, Inc. is the designated Community Transportation Coordinator for Bradford County. Suwannee River Economic Council, Inc.'s Memorandum of Agreement will expire June 30, 2018.

The Council issued Request for Proposals No. 2017-02 for Bradford County Community Transportation Coordinator designation on November 2, 2017. The following firms submitted proposals in response to the request for proposals: Suwannee River Economic Council, Inc. and Transitions Commute Solutions, LLC.

As required by Rule 41-2.010 (4)(c) of the Florida Administrative Code, Request for Proposals No. 2017-02 specified that proposals must include a current financial statement prepared by a licensed certified public accountant. Request for Proposals No. 2017-02 further specified that proposals without a current financial statement prepared by a licensed certified public accountant would be rejected without further consideration.

Memo to Council Page 2 March 15, 2018

The Transitions Commute Solutions, LLC proposal did not include a current financial statement prepared by a licensed certified public accountant. Thus, it is recommended that the Transitions Commute Solutions, LLC proposal be rejected as being nonresponsive to Request for Proposals No. 2017-02.

The Council authorized the Executive Director to appoint a Technical Review Committee to review and score proposals for the Bradford County Community Transportation Coordinator. The Technical Review Committee reviewed Suwannee River Economic Council, Inc.'s proposal and determined that it is responsive to Request for Proposals No. 2017-02. Therefore, it is recommended that the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged designate Suwannee River Economic Council, Inc. the Community Transportation Coordinator for Bradford County for a five-year period effective July 1, 2018.

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-10 A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 UNION COUNTY TRANSPORTATION DISADVANTAGED PLANNING GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA COMMISSION FOR THE TRANSPORTATION DISADVANTAGED WHEREAS, in areas not covered by a metropolitan planning organization, regional planning councils are eligible for selection as designated official planning agencies in accordance with Rule 41-2.009, Florida Administrative Code; WHEREAS, the designated official planning agency is responsible for Transportation Disadvantaged Program planning and providing the local Transportation Disadvantaged Coordinating Board with sufficient staff support and resources to enable the Board to fulfill its responsibilities; and WHEREAS, the North Central Florida Regional Planning Council has the authority to enter into the Fiscal Year 2018-19 Union County Transportation Disadvantaged Planning Grant agreement and to undertake a transportation disadvantaged service project as authorized by Section 427.0159, Florida Statutes and Rule 41-2, Florida Administrative Code. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL THAT:

- 1. The North Central Florida Regional Planning Council has the authority to enter into the above referenced grant agreement;
- The North Central Florida Regional Planning Council authorizes the Chair to execute the Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund Grant agreement on behalf of the North Central Florida Regional Planning Council with the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged;
- 3. The North Central Florida Regional Planning Council authorizes the Executive Director to act in connection with the agreement and to provide such additional information as may be required by the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged;
- 4. The North Central Florida Regional Planning Council authorizes the Chair to sign any and all assurances, agreements or contracts which are required in connection with the Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund Grant Program;
- The North Central Florida Regional Planning Council authorizes its Executive Director to sign the planning grant application form, any and all reimbursement invoices, warranties, certifications and other documents which may be required in connection with the agreement or subsequent agreements; and
- 6. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption.

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached resolution recognizing the 125th Anniversary of the City of Lake Butler.

BACKGROUND:

In recognition of the 125th Anniversary of the establishment of the City of Lake Butler, the attached resolution is recommended for approval by the Council.

In 1859, the City of Lake Butler known as Your Welcome Home Community was established as the county seat of the newly created New River County, later to be named Bradford County in 1861. The lake and city were named after Colonel Robert Butler, the first surveyor general of the Florida Territory and an acting Governor of East Florida. In 1860, a post office was established in Lake Butler. By 1890, the Georgia Southern and Florida Railroad had crossed the county with depots at Guilford and Lake Butler.

Lake Butler prospered and was incorporated as a city in 1893. The Jacksonville and Southwestern Railroad later a branch of the Atlantic Coast Line Railroad, was completed in 1899 serving Raiford, Johnstown, Lake Butler Danville, Dukes and Worthington Springs. In 1921, the Florida Legislature created Union County from that part of Bradford County lying west of the New River. Lake Butler was designated the county seat of the newly created Union County.

Notable persons associated with Lake Butler include actor Jay North, who played the character Dennis in the television series Dennis the Menace between 1959 and 1963. Mr. North moved to Lake Butler, the hometown of his wife Cindy Hackney, in 1993.
