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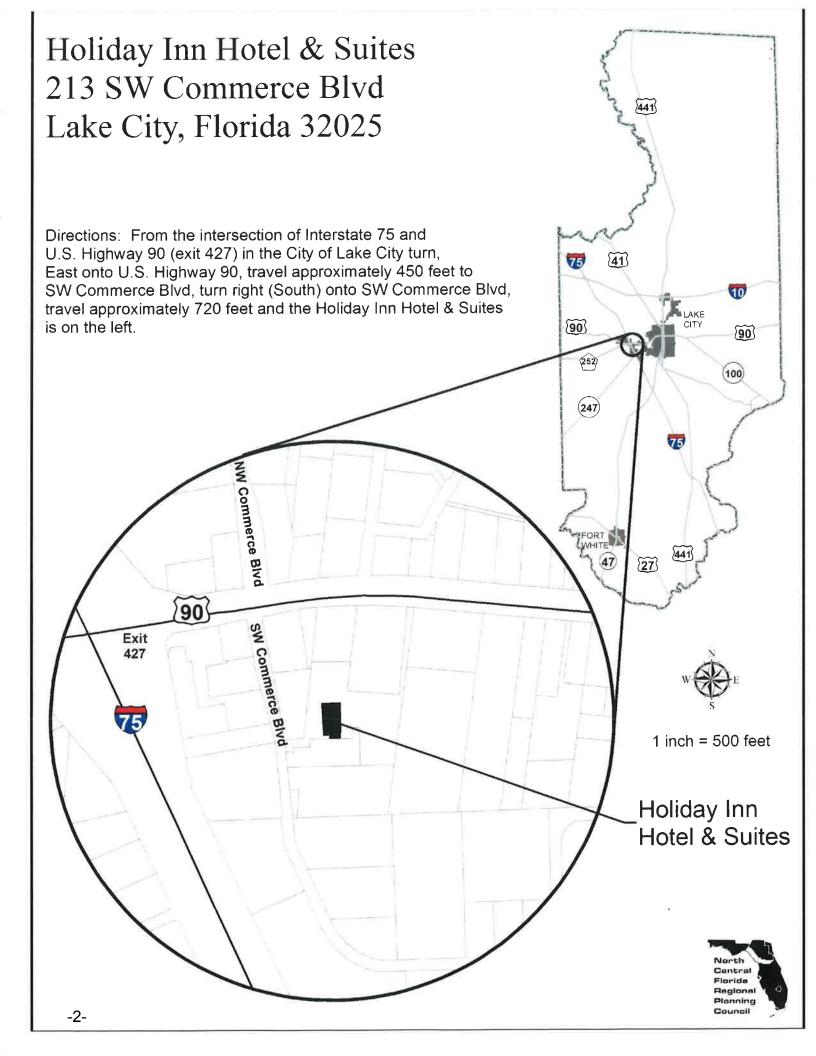

A. 2023-25 U.S. Economic Development Administration Partnership Planning Grant Application

\$210,000 and authorize the Executive Director to execute the grant award if

#### III. PROGRAM REPORT

A. Florida Transportation Disadvantaged Program Community Transportation Coordinator Selection for Bradford and Lafayette Counties

ACTION: Commissioner Demps made the motion, with a second by Commissioner Brown to recommend that the Council authorize the use of the competitive request for proposals process to designate the Community Transportation Coordinators for Bradford and Lafayette Counties; authorize the Executive Director to appoint a Technical Review Committee of at least three Council employees who have experience and knowledge of Florida's Transportation Disadvantaged Program.; and authorize the Technical Review Committee to review, assign points and establish a numerical rank order for the proposals and make recommendations to the Council concerning the designation of the Community Transportation Coordinators for Bradford and Lafayette Counties. The motion carried unanimously.

B. Transportation Disadvantaged Local Coordinating Board Appointment

ACTION: Commissioner Chestnut made the motion, with a second by Mayor Mortimer, to recommend that the Council appoint Iana Patterson the Medical Community Representative on the Bradford County Transportation Disadvantaged Coordinating Board. The motion carried unanimously.
