

to Update Hazards Analyses - Fiscal Year 2025-26

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Executive Director to execute an agreement with the Florida Division of Emergency Management for Fiscal Year 2025-26 to update hazards analyses for Alachua, Bradford, Columbia, Gilchrist, Hamilton, Madison, Suwannee, Taylor and Union Counties for an amount of \$13,283.64.

BACKGROUND:

Each year, the Florida Division of Emergency Management provides funding to the Council to update hazards analyses for locations that contain extremely hazardous substances that if released could cause off-site injuries.

Sites located in the following counties will be included in the hazards analyses update: Alachua, Bradford, Columbia, Gilchrist, Hamilton, Madison, Suwannee, Taylor and Union Counties. The amount of the agreement will be \$13,283.64.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Executive Director to submit a Regional Resiliency Entity Planning Grant Application with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection for Fiscal Year 2025-26 to conduct Phase 1 Critical Assets Mapping for an amount of \$150,000 and, if the grant is awarded by the Department, authorize the Executive Director to sign the grant agreement.

BACKGROUND:

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection is making available regional resiliency entity planning grants for Fiscal Year 2025-26. Regional planning councils are eligible entities to apply for these funds.

The Council proposes to conduct Phase 1 Critical Assets Mapping for the eight north central Florida federally designated Most Impacted and Distressed Counties (Columbia County, Dixie County, Hamilton County, Lafayette County, Levy County, Madison County and Taylor County) by the 2023 and 2024 storms (Hurricane Idalia, Hurricane Debby, Hurricane Helene, Hurricane Milton and the 2024 North Florida Tornadoes). The amount of the grant application is \$150,000.

Phase 2 Critical Asset Mapping in Fiscal Year 2026-27 will include the four north central Florida state designated Most Impacted and Distressed Counties (Alachua County, Bradford County, Gilchrist County and Union County) by the 2023 and 2024 storms (Hurricane Idalia, Hurricane Debby, Hurricane Helene, Hurricane Milton and the 2024 North Florida Tornadoes).

A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 ALACHUA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION DISADVANTAGED PLANNING GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA COMMISSION FOR THE TRANSPORTATION DISADVANTAGED

WHEREAS, regional planning councils are eligible for selection as designated official planning agencies in accordance with Rule 41-2.009, Florida Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, the designated official planning agency is responsible for Transportation Disadvantaged Program planning and providing the local transportation disadvantaged coordinating board with sufficient staff support and resources to enable the board to fulfill its responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the North Central Florida Regional Planning Council has the authority to enter into the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Alachua County Transportation Disadvantaged Planning Grant agreement and to undertake a transportation disadvantaged service project as authorized by Section 427.0159, Florida Statutes, and Rule 41-2, Florida Administrative Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL THAT:

- 1. The North Central Florida Regional Planning Council has the authority to enter into the above referenced grant agreement;
- 2. The North Central Florida Regional Planning Council authorizes the Chair to execute the Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund Grant agreement on behalf of the North Central Florida Regional Planning Council with the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged;
- 3. The North Central Florida Regional Planning Council authorizes the Executive Director to act in connection with the agreement and to provide such additional information as may be required by the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged;
- 4. The North Central Florida Regional Planning Council authorizes the Chair to sign any and all assurances, agreements or contracts which are required in connection with the Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund Grant Program;
- 5. The North Central Florida Regional Planning Council authorizes its Executive Director to sign the planning grant application form, any and all reimbursement invoices, warranties, certifications and other documents which may be required in connection with the agreement or subsequent agreements; and
- 6. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
