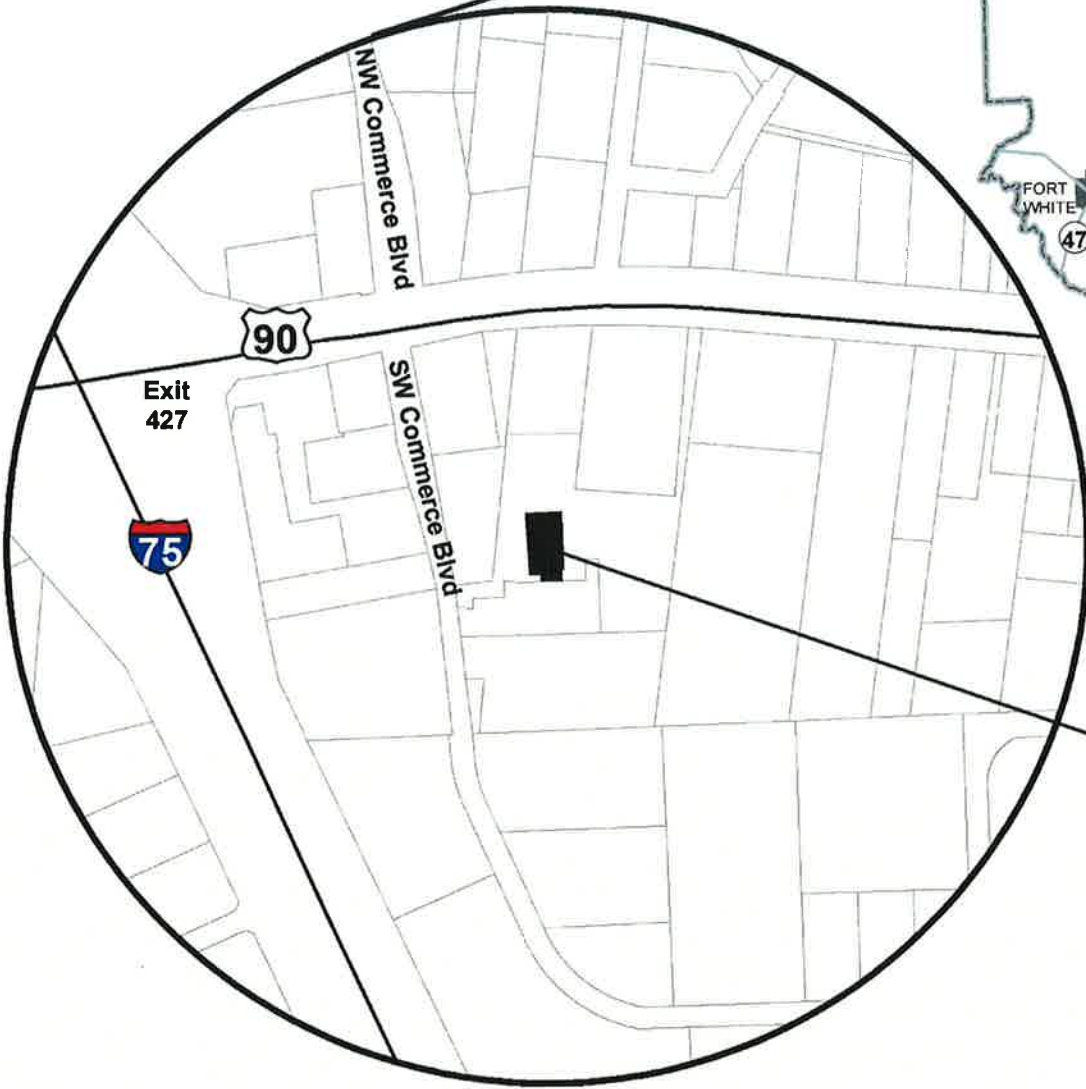

The meeting was called to order by Chair Burnam at 6:33 p.m.

I. APPROVAL OF THE SEPTEMBER 22, 2016 MEETING MINUTES

ACTION: It was moved by Commissioner Chestnut and seconded by Mayor Witt to approve the September 22, 2016 Committee meeting minutes as circulated. The motion carried unanimously.

II. AGENCY COMMENTS REVIEW ON PROPOSED EVALUATION AND APPRAISAL REPORT-BASED AMENDMENTS TO THE NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA STRATEGIC REGIONAL POLICY PLAN

Mr. Dopp presented proposed amendments to the North Central Florida Strategic Regional Policy Plan based on comments received from state agencies and local governments. Mr. Dopp noted that most of the review comments addressed technical issues. He noted that Alachua County Environmental Protection Department proposed the only substantive change, which was to add additional County-owned conservation lands as well as the Priority 3 Ecological Corridor to Illustration III-D of the proposed Evaluation and Appraisal Report-Based Amendments to the North Central Florida Strategic Regional Policy Plan Draft 2016

Mr. Dopp stated that the staff recommends adding Alachua County-owned conservation lands which are equal to or greater than 100 acres in size or are adjacent to a mapped Natural Resource of Regional Significance to Illustration III-D of the proposed Evaluation and Appraisal Report-Based Amendments to the North Central Florida Strategic Regional Policy Plan Draft 2016.

Following discussion by the Committee, the following action was taken.

ACTION: It was moved by Mr. Hunter and seconded by Commissioner Chestnut to add Alachua County-owned conservation lands which are equal to or greater than 100 acres in size or are adjacent to a mapped Natural Resource of Regional Significance to Illustration III-D of the proposed Evaluation and Appraisal Report-Based Amendments to the North Central Florida Strategic Regional Policy Plan Draft 2016 and to forward to the Council for adoption the proposed Evaluation and Appraisal Report-Based Amendments to the North Central Florida Strategic Regional Policy Plan. The motion carried unanimously.
