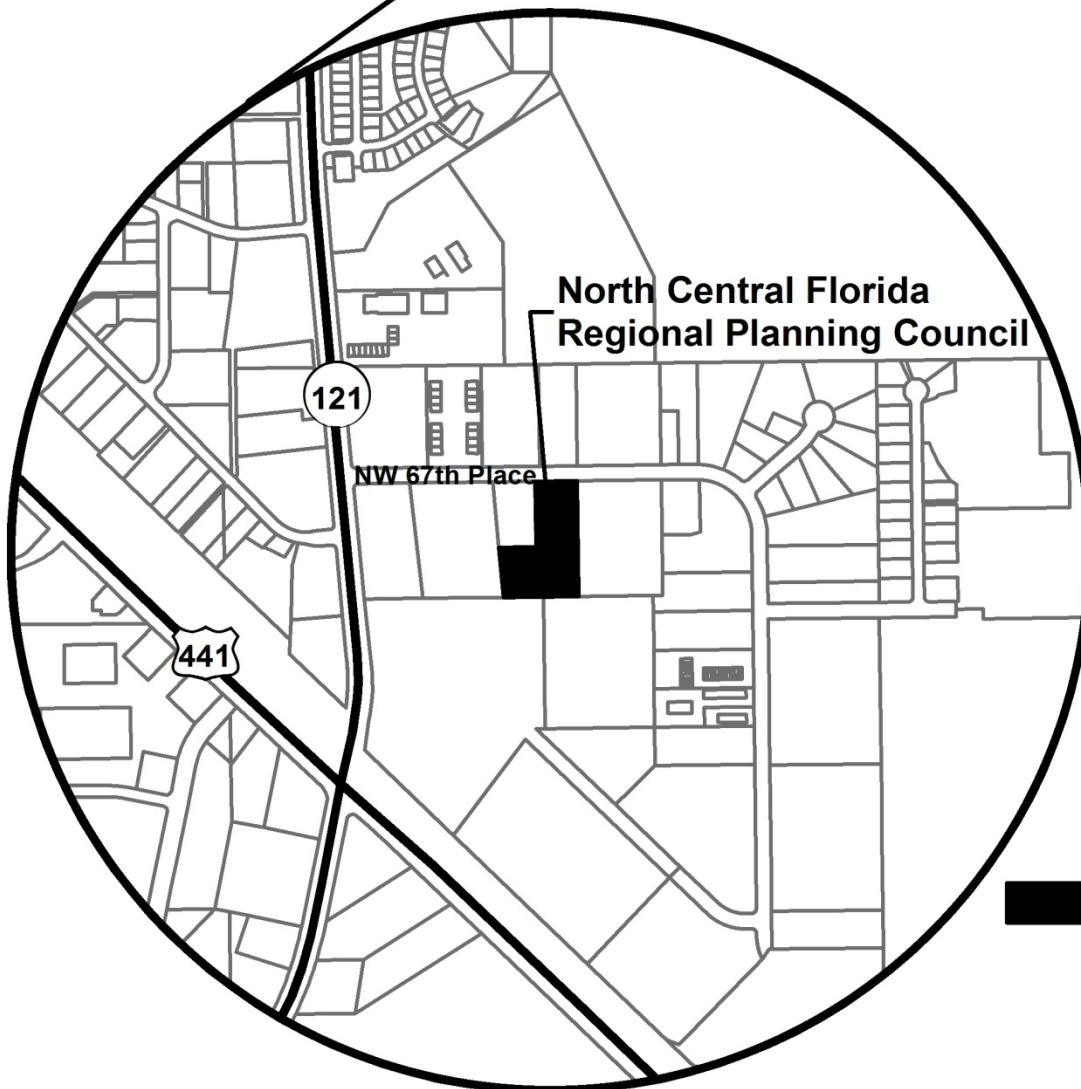
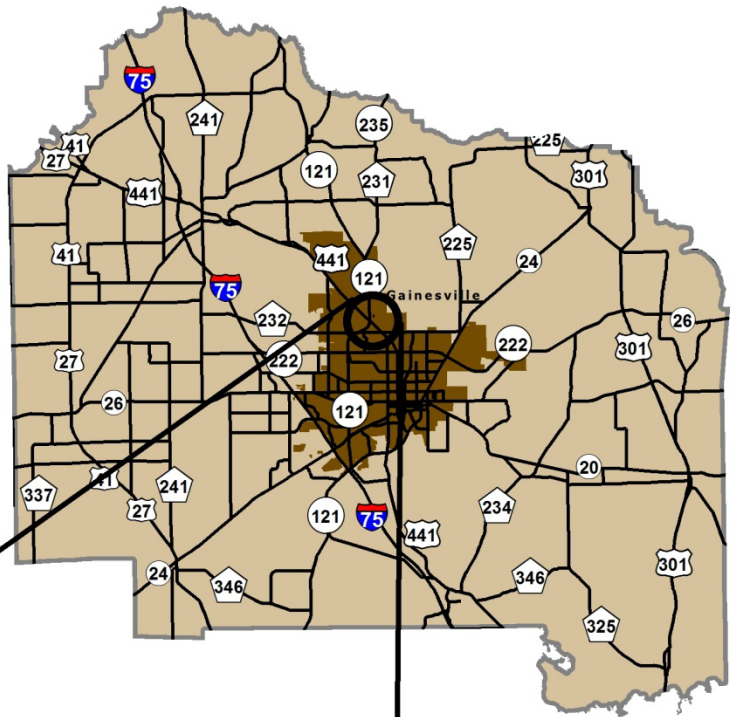
## NOMINATING COMMITTEE
